

## 2018-2019 WELLINGTON WOMEN RULES

1. Wellington Women will bowl every Wednesday at 9:10 AM with practice at 9:00 AM for 34 weeks starting on September 5, 2018 and ending on May 15, 2019. The league will not bowl on November 21, 2018 for Thanksgiving, December 26, 2018 for Christmas, and January 2, 2019 for New Year's. The annual banquet will be held on May 22, 2019.
2. Teams will consist of three (3) ladies.
3. The league will be sanctioned by USBC. Sanction fees: \$ 21. Sanction must be paid on the first day of bowling.
4. Weekly Fees will be \$16 divided as follows: Lineage \$8.00, Prize Fund \$7.25, and Sec/Tres. Fee \$.75. The last 2 weeks of fees are due prior to week 20. No arrears allowed.
5. The league shall use an individual handicap system based on 100% of 200
6. The league shall use a nine (9) point system: 2 Points per game and 3 Points for total series
7. Entering averages will hold for three (3) weeks and be based on: a) Last year's ending Wellington Women's and Manhattan Ladies averages b) Last year highest certifiable average of 21 games or more c) Establish an average with the first 3 games.
8. Vacancy Score shall be 120 with a handicap of 80. The team will be responsible for paying the weekly prize fund and sec. fee of \$8.00 if a vacancy is not filled prior to week 3.
9. When a regular member is absent the team shall use their established average minus 10 pins per game. On the first day of bowling if a regular team member is not present a vacancy score of 120/handicap 80 shall be used.
10. One roster member must be present and ready to bowl to avoid a forfeit. Delay of game is not permitted.
11. A player who arrives late will be permitted to bowl after a game has started, up to and including the 3<sup>rd</sup> frame.
12. Substitutes are permitted. No subs will be allowed on position rounds.
13. In case of a forfeit or uneven number of teams, the team present must bowl 30 pins within their team scratch average per game and 90 pins total to win points. The forfeiting team wins no points.
14. Unopposed bowling is permitted. Teams wishing to pre/post bowl must notify the league secretary for scheduling and should notify the opposing team. All makeup games must be done

prior to the next week's bowling. A computer printout and a recap sheet must be turned in and scores will be posted.

15. Resigning bowlers must give 2 weeks written notice and are responsible for all fees.
16. Team captains are responsible for verifying the team's money envelope and returning it to the Sec/Treas. by the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> game.
17. Position round will be bowled weeks 7, 14, 21, 28, and 34.
18. On the final day of bowling the LOCKOUT RULE will apply. The 1<sup>st</sup> Place team will have to bowl the next team that cannot move up or down. If all teams can move 1<sup>st</sup> Place bowls Last Place
19. An estimated prize fund will be issued and voted on by 51% of the league by week 4.
20. No team or individual shall collect more than 1 special prize with the exception of Most Improved and High Average. A bowler must have bowled 2/3 of the season (64 games) to qualify for an individual award.
21. All leagues funds shall be banked with Greenacres Bowl, checks are acceptable made out to Greenacres Bowl, any returned checks will have a \$25 fee added to the sum of the check and no further checks will be accepted.
22. Lineage is guaranteed to the house by the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of bowling.
23. Banquet monies are nonrefundable as they are a portion of the prize fund.
