1. Strike it Rich is a mixed, managed USBC sanctioned league that bowls Wednesday nights at 7:00pm, starting June 3, 2026, ending August 19, 2026. Optional Fun Night/payout Aug 26, 2026.
2. There are 13 total weeks of bowling; 12 for league and the 13th is payout and **optional** “fun-night.”
3. Weekly fees are \$25/bowler. Lineage, \$14.00; prize fund \$10.00; secretary fee \$1.00. Sanction fee is due by the 1st night of bowling. Summer sanction is \$10 if you are bowling only for one league in the summer. If you paid sanction in Sept. 2025, you are covered.
4. Practice starts at 6:50 pm and bowling for score at 7:00 pm. Late bowlers have until the **beginning of the 3rd frame** (of nearest full pair to the right) to be ready to bowl. A minimum line-up consists of two (2) eligible bowlers (Rule 109a) who must be present and ready to bowl at the start of league play.
5. Teams should have a name submitted on the recap sheets by the 2nd week. The team captain is responsible for verifying all league fees in the envelope and recording scores on recap sheets. Envelopes should be turned in to the secretary by the 5th frame of the first game.
6. Teams can be any combination of men/women. **Substitutes are permitted, except on position rounds. Maximum number of bowlers per roster is six (6).** No new roster members on position round or the last two regular weeks of a session. Roster members need 3 complete games to bowl on position round. Team captains must notify the secretary of a sub, prior to them bowling. According to USBC, subs must have current sanction; a verifiable book average and fill-out a sanction card for the league. Substitutes are not responsible for bowling fees.
7. **The last two weeks must be pre-paid by the week of Aug 5, 2026.**
8. The league uses an individual handicap of 90-percent of 220 and 9-point score system: 2 points/game & 3 points for total. The 10-pin drop rule is in effect. The board can rerate someone’s average if warranted.
9. If a blind score is used, **FULL WEEKLY** fees are owed; the score is 10 pins less than their current average (not book) per game. Vacancy fee is \$12.00 per week, score is 130 & handicap is 81 pins.
10. **Checks payable to Laura Danowski/Strike It Rich.** Returned items: \$25.00 fee to be paid in cash.
11. No team is permitted to be more than one (1) week behind in funds owed. This includes any combination of weekly fees, sanction costs or any returned bank items. Points don’t count while a team is in arrears.

12. A bowler's entering average will be based on (sanctioned) criteria which holds for 3 games:
 - a. Strike It Rich ending average from fall 2025 – spring 2026
 - b. Strike It Rich ending average from summer 2025
 - c. Within 1-year, highest book average, most number of games. Legal avg. is 21-games or more.
 - d. Any bowler not meeting the criteria will establish average by bowling 3 games in this league.
13. Any bowler withdrawing from the league is asked to give a two-week, written notice to both the team captain and a league officer. At that time bowler is responsible for two (2) weeks bowling fees, unless an immediate replacement is made. Failure to execute proper exit can result in suspension from USBC. If a team doesn't replace the member, it is responsible for league fees until it does.
14. In the event of a forfeit (USBC Rule 110c) or if the league has an uneven number of teams, the legal team must bowl within 40 pins of their team average to win points and within 120 pins for total points.
15. Pre-bowling is permitted as a team or individual. Post-bowling is permitted as a team. No pre- or post-bowling for position rounds, unless there is unavoidable circumstance. Anything appearing questionable requires league officer vote. Greenacres requires pre-registration for pre- and post-bowling. **There is a per bowler \$5.35 fee.** Emergency postponements are accepted; an emergency is determined by board members. Lane assignments are at the discretion of the house; all said matches must be completed by the next scheduled league session. Any pre- or post-bowled scores may be entered into the computer at the time of league play. **No outstanding or USBC Honor scores from pre- or post-bowling are recognized other than win/loss.**
16. Ties for first place will be decided by a one-game roll-off, completed immediately after bowling on the last night of league play. If the first-place team has sufficient points to eliminate second place for a shot at first place, the lock-out rule is used. First-place team bowls the next available team that can **neither move-up nor down** in standings. If all teams **can move-up or down**, first place bowls last place team.
17. Ties other than first place will combine the respective prize monies and divide it evenly.
18. Once a ball is in play, it can only be wiped with a clean dry cloth. All unused finger holes must be filled. If you don't use it all the time, every roll, it must be filled.
19. To be eligible for individual awards, a bowler must have completed 2/3 of the games in this league. No team or individual may receive more than one league award, except the two individual USBC awards of high-average and most improved average.
20. By vote taken Jun 10, we bowl 2-balls/person in practice. Result: 11-teams to 6-teams
21. Any rules not covered herein will be governed by USBC rules.
