Purpose:

To assist the Head Mechanic with the maintenance of our AMF Pinsetters to ensure smooth operation for our guests. Complete all tasks assigned by Head Mechanic with regards to building and property maintenance. Assumes responsibility for the department and staff in the absence of the Head Mechanic.

Essential Duties:

- Must possess full knowledge and understanding of the Mechanic Class "C" & "B" duties
- Must be a team player and possess the ability to learn
- Proficient knowledge of AMF Pinsetter preventative maintenance best practices and the implementation of same
- Proficient knowledge of the Brunswick Sync scoring system
- Proficient knowledge of the Kegel Kustodian Walker lane machine
- Performs routine maintenance and repairs both as directed by the Head Mechanic and proactively on their own.
- Maintains and repairs pin setters, ball returns, lane machine, scoring equipment etc.
- Performs routine building maintenance (air filters, light bulb replacement, basic plumbing & electrical, painting, etc.)
- Assists in the accurate recording of supply inventories and orders
- Rebuilds and overhauls assemblies
- Complete daily and weekly tasks assigned by the Head Mechanic
- Assist in training "Class C" and "Class B" mechanics
- Complete any other task assigned by management

Basic Skills:

Must be at least 18 years of age. Must have the ability to stand for 8 hours. Must be able to lift 75lbs. Possess high school diploma or equivalent. Basic mechanical abilities. Must have 5 years' experience as a bowling center mechanic. Must have knowledge of bowling center machinery. Must possess knowledge and use of tools and lube equipment. Ability to use power tools in an efficient and safe manner. Ability to train others. Electrical experience preferred but not required.
