Palm Beach County USBC Youth 2023 County Tournament Rules

USBC Tournament rules will prevail. USBC youth members are not permitted to play game machines while in the tournament. NO food or beverages will be allowed in the bowling settee area. USBC youth bowlers will not be permitted to use any kind of tobacco products or intoxicants while in the tournament establishment.

Only members of the Palm Beach County USBC youth bowlers are eligible to enter.

The tournament will be conducted on an average basis of two divisions, regardless of the age of the bowler. Division average breakdown and handicap are as outlined on the front of this entry form.

Events will be TEAM – 4 bowlers, DOUBLES, SINGLES, ALL EVENTS, Teams and Doubles may be any combination of boys and/or girls. Singles and All Events will have a boys and girls division **(if any division has less than 5 entries, it will be combined with the opposite sex of the same division)**. A bowler must bowl both Singles and Doubles. Singles event will be bowled first. Bowlers will not change lanes between Singles and Doubles. There will be NO practice between Singles and Doubles. All participants will bowl three games in each event. Substitutes will be allowed.

Multiple entries will be permitted in Team, Singles, & Doubles
Entries DEADLINE will be MIDNIGHT on February 3rd 2023
No entries will be accepted without full payment. NO EXCEPTIONS!!
Entry fees are \$25.00 per event. Bowling/Awards/Expense

The average that will be used must be a USBC average and will be based on the following:
Bowlers will use their 2021/2022 yearbook or January 1st, 2023 of twelve (12) games or more whichever is higher.
Bowlers without the above can use a current average of 12 games or more as of February 1, 2023, with proof, otherwise they must bowl scratch.

Bowlers must bowl in the same order as listed on the entry form and on the score sheet. Any bowler arriving late will begin to bowl in the frame being bowled and their score to count from that frame and a zero entered for any and all frames missed.

If a lane breaks down or any other delay happens, there will be NO practice when bowling resumes, whether the bowlers are moved or not.

All entrants must report 45 minutes before assigned time to bowl. If any substitutes are to be made, the coach must report to the tournament official at least ONE hour before time to bowl.

Awards will be given to the champion in each division. In case of a tie for first place, duplicate trophies will be awarded and co-champions will be declared. Awards will be given to first place winners in All Events for each division, Scratch, & Handicap boys and girls.

There will be NO changes in schedule or refund of entry fee once time and dates have been assigned.

No unnecessary delay will be allowed. Any bowler not present and ready to bowl when it is their time to bowl will receive a zero for the frames missed.

PROPER ATTIRE IS REQUIRED!! Shorts and skirts must be below fingertip length, no halter or tank tops, shirts must have sleeves and shirts MUST cover the naval area. Boy's pants must be at waist level and secured with a belt if necessary and NO underwear exposed. Tee shirts cannot contain offensive language, symbols, innuendos, or advertisement of tobacco products or alcohol. NO headgear of any kind is permitted during tournament play.
